The Federal Trade Commission says about Made in USA...

“Made in USA” is a protected statement reserved for products that comply with strict U.S. federal manufacturing guidelines. It is intended to provide confidence to consumers seeking to buy American-made products without concern about the origin of the product’s materials or manufacturing process.

What does it mean to be “Made in USA?” According to the Federal Trade Commission (FTC), “Made in USA” means that “all or virtually all” of the product has been made in the United States. That is, all significant parts, processing and labor that go into the product must be of U.S. origin. Products should not contain any – or only negligible – foreign content.

Tri-Tronics complies with most of this, but obviously there are parts that are manufactured only in the Low Cost Regions of the world...components, cables, connectors, etc. So, with that said, we can honestly state that “all” of the design is “Made in USA”, and none of the electronic components comply, but “Virtually All” of the labor, assembly, and manufacturing are truly “Made in USA”.
